Give it a try! Take a few minutes to brainstorm as many different things in each prompt category as you can. Then, choose item(s) from each category for the designated "blank" in the poem. The prompts have a way of drawing out memories of the smell and bottom-drawer keepsakes; the faces of long-departed kin, the sound of their voices you still hold some deep place in memory. You'll be surprised that, when you're done, you will have said things about the sources of your unique you-ness that you'd never considered before. What's more, you will have created something of yourself to share.
